OUR STORY

Founded by Florida (Flo) DeVaul-Dudley, Shining Light In Darkness was inspired by her personal experiences of childhood molestation, date rape, sexual assault, and domestic violence. These traumatic experiences, coupled with a traumatic car accident in 2015 that triggered PTSD, led her to seek therapy and self-education. Her husband and co-founder, ED Dudley, witnessed the broader impact of these issues on her and others, motivating them to build an organization that provides support, education, and resources for survivors of trauma and their loved ones.


